Key Vocabulary	Definition
Viking	People who came from the Germany to live in England during the 5^{th} Century.
Mercia	A word used to describe people who believe in many Gods and Goddesses, often relating to the natural world. During Anglo-Saxon times people believed many different things.
invasion	A country or place ruled by a King or Queen.
Anglo-Saxon	An unexpected attack where an enemy comes to steal and/or destroy.
pagan	An Anglo-Saxon Kingdom in England, once ruled by a King called Offa who made coins for trading.
kingdom	People who travelled from Northern Europe to other regions including England. The Vikings raided and traded with other regions.
Wessex	To enter a country or place by force with the intent of taking over.
raid	Buying and selling goods or services.
trade	An Anglo-Saxon Kingdom in England, once ruled by Alfred the Great.
