Friday: Recap both sounds taught this week.

Daily Phase 1 Listening & Attention Tasks

Monday: Grown ups – Oral blending in Phase 1 of phonics doesn't require any knowledge of letters. It is the children's listening skills that are developing before the introduction of letters. So you are saying the sounds and the children are listening and responding. It can be tricky for the children at first, so you may need to make it really obvious! Have a look at this video for examples of oral blending in action, then choose one of the games to have a go at. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=tv4E_D9t2jU

Tuesday: Play Simon Says with a grown up. Grown ups – During the game, say some of the words in sound talk. For example "Simon says sit d-ow-n".

Wednesday: Grown ups - When learning about oral blending, we often refer to 'fred talk' as this is how we sound when we are speaking in sounds! Today, make your own robot! It can be a painting, from junk modelling or a cereal box or even a robot mask. If it can have a hole to post cards in it can be used in a variety of activities in the future. Friday: Finish the week with a story. Grown ups – As you are reading the story, choose a few words to say in 'fred talk' - you'll be getting very good at this by now.

Daily Ongoing Activities

- Daily name practice – Trace over your name and also practice copying your name.
- Daily oral counting practice – Count forwards to 10 and backwards from 10. Which number comes in between 3 and 5?”
- Daily weather forecast – what is the weather like today?
- Daily story – share a book together.

Additional Practical Activities

- Play I spy – “I spy with my little eye something beginning with ...”
- In the kitchen – Lay the table with plates and bowls. “How many bowls are there?” “How many plates?” “How many altogether?” (numbers to 10).
- Metal Mike – Put out 5 cvc objects in front of the child eg dog, cat, van, book, fork. Adult to segment a word to say ie “d”-“o”-“g” for the child to identify and find.
- In the garden/an outdoor space – Using stones and sticks make repeating patterns eg stone, stick, stone, stick, stone, stick etc or stone, stone, stick, stone, stone, stick etc

Weekly Fine Motor Activities

Support your child with buttoning and unbuttoning different items of clothing.



Give your child a spoon full of chickpeas/kidney beans to count. Ask them to place bean onto a plate or into a container as they count.
