

Daily Maths Lessons	Daily English and Phonics
<p>Monday: Number of the week : 1 This week we will be learning all about the number 1. Watch this video to get started. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7APNVVdrx5M</p>	<p>Monday: Listen to the story: 'When will it be Spring?' https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=xaile9iScQ8</p>  <p>Talk to your grown up about what happens in the story.</p>
<p>Tuesday: Have a toy picnic. Give each toy 1 plate, 1 cup, 1 spoon maybe even 1 bun!</p>	<p>Tuesday: Listen to the story again: 'When will it be Spring?' https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=xaile9iScQ8 This time talk to your grown up about what happens in the story. What season are we in now? What is the weather like? What other seasons do we have? What are the differences in those seasons?</p>
<p>Wednesday: Go on a number hunt around your house looking for the number 1. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=jwQ3eeu5o9g</p>	<p>Wednesday: Today Read the story again and answer some questions about the story with your grown up.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What is the name of the little bear? • What did he see on the second day when he woke up? • What did Alfie actually see when he thought he saw butterflies? • Why do you think Alfie was actually sleeping when Spring had come? • What do you think you will see in Spring and Summer?
<p>Thursday : Learn about 1 with Ten town. (Login) Listen to King One's story and his Song.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What does King One eat for breakfast? • What does King One ride around on in Ten Town? • Which different body parts does King One mention in his song? <p>Game: Play King One's 'more or less' game. Activity: Find the sets (Login to Ten Town)</p>	<p>Thursday: Can you draw a picture of your favourite part of the story and talk about what you have drawn with your grown up.</p>
<p>Friday: Practise writing the number 1. Write in the air, write it outside with some chalk. Don't forget the rhyme- 'From top toe and there you go'. Game: King One's number tracing game. (Login to Ten Town)</p>	<p>Friday: Can you write a list of things you will see when it is Spring? What sound does it begin with? Draw some pictures of some of the changes you will see.</p>

Daily Phase 1 Listening & Attention Tasks

Monday: Make some listening ears to help you do good listening at home! A template is available on Twinkl or you can make your own using any available resources and design you like!



Tuesday: Go into the garden with your listening ears and listen carefully to the sounds you can hear. Some sounds will be loud and some you might need to listen more carefully for. Ask a grown up to help you make a list using drawings.

Wednesday: Wear your listening ears whilst looking around your home. Can you find things that make sounds around the house? Washing machines, taps, creaky floorboards and hinges, toilet flushes, clocks. Again, make a list using drawings.

Thursday: Wear your listening ears to play a listening game. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=h0Kp_J9kvNM

Friday: Make a collection of noisy objects from around the home! You could sort them into different groups, e.g. loud noises and quiet noises.

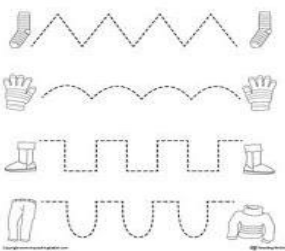
