



William Murdoch Primary School Changes to the School Site and Building

All entrances have been closed off and only the Albert Road gate will be used. We have created a one-way system: one gate will be used to enter the school site and the other to exit. Markers have been placed to ensure parents keep a 2m distance when collecting and dropping their children off. Children will need to be accompanied to school by an adult; both the adult and child will need to wait at a marker for temperature checks and hand sanitising to take place. Only one adult per child will be allowed on to the school premises.



Classrooms have been rearranged so that children can be seated at a 2m distance where possible. The number of pupils per classroom will be limited to 8 to enable social distancing guidance to be adhered to. Each child will be allocated a seat which they will use for the duration of the time at school.

Additional furniture has been stored away. Shared resources have been removed and children will be given their own resource packs.

The playground has been sectioned off so that each bubble can be given a designated outdoor space for breaktimes and lunchtimes. The timetable has been altered so that breaktimes and lunchtimes are staggered which will ensure bubbles do not mix. Each bubble will also have their own outdoor equipment to use.

The outdoor space will be utilised as much as possible throughout the day.
