Class Dojo

At William Murdoch Primary School, we use Class Dojo as our remote learning platform. Class Dojo provides a way for children to complete learning online and submit work to their class teacher. As parents, you can see the work set by the class teacher and the completed homework submitted by your child. On 'Class Story', you will be able to see information and updates.

We also want to make it easier for you to communicate with your child's class teacher, therefore you will be able to use the messaging feature within Class Dojo and message your child's teacher directly. However, this should not be used for sensitive issues nor for reporting absences. All efforts will be made to respond to messages within two working days.

There will be two homework tasks each week assigned by the class teacher specifically on Class Dojo. The completed work must be submitted via Class Dojo and includes the following:

- Letter formation
- Number formation

Once complete, this homework will need to be uploaded to Class Dojo, using your child's account. **Please note, parents are unable to upload homework using their parent account.**
