TOP TIPS FOR A PERSUASIVE SPEECH

- ✓ Make eye contact; use your voice, body language and facial expressions.
- ✓ Make sure your body language and tone of voice fits what you are talking about e.g. if you're talking about something sad don't smile.
- ✓ Don't move around too much.
- ✓ Stand up straight with your head up and shoulders back- everyone will think you're really confident!
- ✓ Sound like you care about what you're talking about— if you sound bored your audience will be bored too!
- ✓ Use interesting and persuasive language if you just say "good" and "bad" all the time it won't be as effective.
- ✓ Have a strong opening so that you grab the
