Phonics Tasks

Day 1:

The sound we are going to look at today is ay – May I play.

Play Buried Treasure on phonics play focusing on the ay sound – your child must identify the real words and alien words and put them in the correct places.

Day 2:

The sound we are going to look at today ee – What can you see?

Your child needs to complete the wordfind worksheet focusing on the ee sound. (Resource 1).

Day 3:

The sound we are going to look at today igh – Fly high

Your child needs to look at the grid and find all the words with the igh sound. Your child is only allowed to colour the words with the igh sound in. Remember to special friends, Fred talk the words to find out what they say, then read the word. (Resource 2).

Day 4:

The sound we are going to look at today ow – Blow the snow

Look at the list of real words and alien words. Underline the special friends and Fred talk them. Can you think of a sensible sentence for the real words and a silly sentence for the alien words (Resource 3).

The sound we are going to look at today oo – Poo at the zoo

Further Learning Opportunities

Art Knowledge Organiser: Your child will need to complete the art knowledge organiser 'Investigating Sculpture'. They will need to fill in the missing words using the vocabulary list and they will also need to use the information to answer the questions.

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to learn more about volcanoes. What do they do? Where they are located in the world?

Your child will research and explore different volcanoes all over the world, some in places where your child will not expect. After this research project, your child will have the exciting opportunity to make their own erupting volcano.

Ask your child what they know about volcanoes? Do they know where any of the volcanoes are in the world? Do they know what happens when a volcano erupts?

After watching these videos your child should know a lot more about volcanoes. Ask your child to think about some of the key vocabulary they heard in those videos.

Such as:

Magma

Lava

Crater

Eruptions

Ash clouds

Your child should now do more research with your support on the internet about different locations of volcanoes around the world. Are they able to locate volcanoes that are under the sea and under ice caps?

Once they have got a good understanding of:

What volcanoes are?
What happens when they erupt?
Where they are located?

Your child should now try to create their own erupting volcano!

Equipment needed:

- Water bottle
- Scissors
- Foil
- Vinegar
- Baking soda
- Baking tray
- Red food colouring

Instructions:

1. Get all the equipment above ready.
2. Cut the bottle in half using the scissors.
3. Place the bottom half of the bottle in the middle of the baking tray.
4. Scrunch up some foil and surround the bottle with foil (it should look like the picture above).
5. Put two tablespoons of baking soda into the bottle.
6. Mix a small amount of red food colouring in with a cup full of vinegar.
7. Once they are mixed start to pour the red vinegar slowly into the bottle.
8. The volcano will then start to 'erupt'
9. Once your child has completed this as many times as they want, you can just throw it in the bin.



Once your child has finished with this experiment, they should evaluate the process. What could they do next time to make their volcano more realistic? Could they paint it? Could they use papier-mâché instead of foil etc?
