Weekly Reading Task

Day 1:

Read your Home Reader/Library book aloud for at least 15 minutes. Describe the front cover of the book. What clues does it give you about the story?

Day 2

Read the comprehension sheet 'Enormous Eruptions' then answer the Retrieval Focus questions and the Vipers questions.

Day 3

Read your Home Reader/Library book aloud for at least 15 minutes. From the current chapter: Find and copy into your exercise book any sentences which you can find beginning with a fronted adverbial. (V19).

Day 4

Read the comprehension sheet 'Making Candles'. Copy the text out in your best handwriting. Answer all of the questions.

Day 5

Read your Home Reader/Library book aloud for at least 15 minutes. From the current chapter: Did anything in this chapter surprise you? Why? (S21)

<p><u>Day 2:</u> Write the definitions of each word.</p> <p><u>Day 3:</u> Choose 5-8 words from the list and write a sentence for each. Remember your capital letters and full stops.</p> <p><u>Day 4:</u> Write a synonym for each word from the list. <i>Challenge:</i> Write an antonym for each word.</p> <p><u>Day 5:</u> CGP English Grammar Year 4 Book page 4 and 5 - Verbs and Adverbs.</p>	<p><u>Day 1:</u> Write 5-8 questions that you would want to ask and find out about the picture. Remember to use ‘?’</p> <p><u>Day 2:</u> Describe the setting shown in the picture.</p> <p><u>Day 3:</u> Plan a short story about the events in the picture and what might happen next. Think about what genre you want the story to be for example: comedy, horror, sci-fi, romantic, adventure.</p> <p><u>Day 4:</u> Write up your story and think about whether it can be made more interesting. Remember to include noun phrases, similes, fronted adverbials.</p> <p><u>Day 5:</u> DEBATE: Every home should own a pet. Write 3 points FOR and AGAINST the view. Then, write a short summary of what you believe and explain why.</p>
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Learning Project- to be completed throughout the week:

The project this week aims to provide opportunities for your child to learn more about the area in which they live. Learning may focus on your local area, famous people, key landmarks and links to your city.

THINK AND WRITE

Think about their street. What types of houses are on their street? What type of house do they live in? What other buildings are close by? Find out about your local area (Handsworth) and what different buildings does it have? How old are some of those buildings? How have they changed over time? Use a map to locate different places.

THINK AND DRAW

Choose a building they most admire in their local area (Handsworth). Make a model of that building using materials of their choice. (Playdough, lego, paper) How well did they do? What would they do differently next time? What have they learnt?
