Find out about your local area (Handsworth) and what different buildings does it have? How old are some of those buildings? How have they changed over time? Use a map to locate different places.

THINK AND DRAW

Choose a building they most admire in their local area (Handsworth). Make a model of that building using materials of their choice. (Playdough, lego, paper) How well did they do? What would they do differently next time? What have they learnt?
