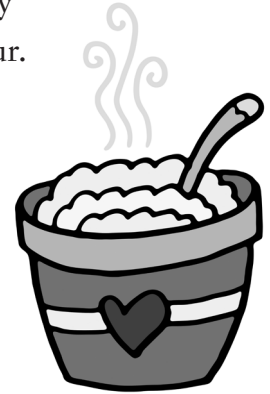


Mother Bear's Worries
